REGISTRATION DETAILS

Fees: \$180 – first child (add \$3 for credit card payment);
\$280 – two children from the same family (add \$5 for credit card payment);
\$295 – three children from the same family (add \$5 for credit card payment).

Uniforms: In 2009, all new players will be issued with a team jacket and cap (at no charge). Jackets will be required to be worn to all matches during the season. Existing players who received a jacket in 2008 can purchase a replacement if required.

Team Structure (age based as at 1st January 2009) and proposed Divisions/Grades:

Tackers - Under 8/9 – Proposed 3 teams – maximum 22 players per team (birth year 2000/01/02)

Under 10 – Proposed 2 teams – maximum 22 players per team

Under 11 – Proposed 2 teams – maximum 24 players per team

Under 12 – Proposed 2 teams – maximum 24 players per team

Under 13 – Proposed 2 teams – maximum 24 players per team

Under 14 – Proposed 2 teams – maximum 26 players per team

Under 15 – 1 team – maximum 26 players per team

Colts - 2 teams playing as Boroondara Hawks

- Preference of entry will be given to RETURNING players **up until** 11.00am on the 15th February 2009.
- Return your registration form and payment by post in the envelope provided to secure a position in a team or attend on Registration Day.
- Acceptance of NEW Registrations will be based on “first in” basis on Registration Day. New players must attend Registration Day with required paperwork/payment. The Club reserves the right to refuse Registration if paperwork and payment is not provided.
- When a team is filled parents will be advised, with the option to join a waiting list.

Returning Players: Check details (personal and medical) on enclosed form.
Parent/guardian must sign the form where indicated.
Return form/s and payment by post in the envelope provided.
Complying forms will be date stamped when received by the Registrar.
If you are experiencing financial difficulties, please contact the Registrar to discuss solutions and still ensure a place for your child.

Copy of birth certificate, medical details and payment **MUST** be given on this day.

REGISTRATION FORM CHANGES

Please note the following changes / additions to the 2009 Registration and Medical Consent form.

1. The club needs to know who has first aid or trainer qualifications as we need to ensure a qualified person is in attendance at all games.
2. A consent section regarding the use of your child's photo in promotional and marketing publications.
3. An indication of your future interest in assisting the club through an involvement in the Committee, as a potential coach or team manager, or helping with social and fund raising initiatives.

MOUTHGUARDS

Mouthguards are *mandatory* for Junior Football - they protect teeth from 90% of all impact injuries. Please ensure your child's protection by purchasing from chemists/sports stores good quality mouthguards or organising moulded fittings through your dentist.

CLUB UNIFORM

The CJFC uniform: **RED** shorts are for *HOME* games and **WHITE** shorts for *AWAY* games. Failure to wear the correct colour shorts can result in the Club being fined (imposed by the YJFL). RED socks are to be worn for all games. Club shorts will be available for sale on Registration Day.
